Storage and Handling

- Store off the floor on a shelf or pallet.
- > Shelf life 36 months.

Preparation

- > Product supplied non-sterile.
- Inspect products before processing.
- > Withdraw damaged products and report to manager.
- Rinse with warm water to remove any packaging residues.

- Beaker.
- Spout lid.
- Feeder lid.

Cleaning and Disinfection

- Position products individually, avoiding contact with other items. \geq
- \geq Position products to allow water penetration and drainage.
- \succ Machine clean in washer disinfectors compliant with ISO 15883.
- Use approved detergents, enzymatic or biocide cleaners, suitable for cleaning medical devices.
